Comprehensive Agronomy Trial

- 18 treatments in total
- Nitrogen rates: 110 lbs N pre-plant and in crop applications to top up to 1 to 3 lb N per bu canola;
- Seeding rates: 78 to 141 seeds/sq m.
- Treatments planted with drill and twin row planter.
- UAV imagery measuring canopy density.
- All treatments analysed for profitability.

Canola Agronomy Demo Stations

1. Fertility — split rates, timing and economics.
2. Seeding — Demo on seeding rate effect on plant density, insect /disease, and profitability.
3. Pests and disease — reduce your risk.

Harvest Management Session

Dry down options. How to harvest a heavy crop.

- Fungicide and boron trials.
